

CORONA DEL SOL BAND CAMP 2010

Congratulations!

You have been accepted into the 2010 Aztec Marching Band and invited to the 2010 Band Camp! As a selected participant, you will find this to be one of the finest marching band experiences in the Southwest United States. With this honor comes a great deal of responsibility. Please check the Tentative Schedule and Estimated Costs Sheet. Make sure that you can meet all of the season's commitments!

Band camp activities begin on July 27 with a leadership forum with Scott Lang and end on August 7th with a concert in the cool pines of Camp Tonto Rim in Northern Arizona. Here is the list of dates for our pre-band camp activities:

- **End of Year/Summer Sectionals & Marching Rehearsals:** These are required – Please refer to the included Rehearsal schedule, as there are different dates for woodwind and brass instruments. If you are in town, please be there on time! If you are on vacation with your family, please contact Mr. DuPlessis (coronaband@gmail.com) to excuse the absence BEFORE the rehearsal.
- July 26-29 (tentative) – **CdS Book Distribution** - 8AM - 12PM & 1PM - 3PM (even if you're scheduled for different days, you may pick up your books any time.). Remember to request a band locker.
- July 27 (tentative date) – **Marching Band Member Scott Lang Workshop (ALL Marching Band Members) @ Corona del Sol High School.** All members go from 1 until 3:30 pm; Student Leaders stay until 4:30 pm. This is required for all members! *This is a tentative date – if it changes, students will be notified well in advance.*
- Sat. July 31st - **Camp Student/Parent Meeting** 8:00 AM in the Corona Auditorium Lobby for new members to be fit for shoes & gloves, 10:00 AM in the Auditorium for the All Band Family meeting to go over Band Camp details.

The Corona del Sol Aztec Marching Band will depart for Camp Tonto Rim for their annual **Summer Marching Band Camp** on **Sunday August 1st at 1 pm**. Members will be at camp **through Saturday, August 7th**. The Summer Marching Band Camp is REQUIRED for all marching band members, so make summer plans accordingly!

The purpose of the camp is to get the year kicked off to a great start and to get the fundamentals of marching learned while avoiding the valley heat. Camp also offers the opportunity to build strong personal relationships within the band, so that the marching season runs much more smoothly. All of the camp and pre-camp activities are VERY IMPORTANT and thus we need 100% attendance!!!

A more detailed Camp Schedule will be given out in May.

Parents must pick up their student(s) from Camp on **Saturday, August 7th**. Families are encouraged to attend the Camp BBQ from 11am-12pm on Saturday; order forms are included in the band camp packet. We will end camp with a celebratory concert at 12pm. Transportation is not provided back to Tempe. All parents are expected to come on

Saturday, Aug 7th, OR make arrangements for their student(s) to ride home with another family. If Freshmen Orientation conflicts with Camp, freshmen band members will go to an alternative orientation so they can still go to Band Camp.

Students will stay in cabins and dormitories of various sizes at Camp. There is a nice dining hall with staff provided to prepare all of the meals. The students will be instructed by various staff and a few parents will be at camp to help with various duties as well. Band Camp 2010 should prove to be exciting and memorable for all!

Camp Fees

The cost of camp is \$375.00, which covers everything outlined here, including bus transportation to camp.

Estimated Costs for participation in the Aztec Marching Band

Below is a list of expenses that marching band students can expect to pay throughout the course of the season.

SCHOOL FEES

Course Fee: Some courses including Band (JV Band, Intermediate Band, Varsity Band, Wind Ens.) have a course fee that needs to be paid at book distribution in July that covers the cost of supplies used in the class. Last year, this fee was \$30 for concert band.

Activity Fee: The activity fee was designed to help offset the Maintenance & Operation expense of providing extra-curricular student activities in the Tempe Union High School District. This is why we charge \$50.00 for the activity outlined in policy GCB-E. The TUHSD board voted upon this fee in April 2003. Please see the activity fee schedule. These fees are \$50.00 per activity (including MARCHING BAND) with a maximum of \$150.00 for any one student and no family maximum.

CAMPS/TRIPS costs for ALL Band members

Summer Band Camp, Aug 1-7 - \$375.00 (\$350 if paid before April 26; \$400 if paid after May 21)
California Trip for Competition, Oct 29-Oct 31 (estimated cost) \$250.00

INSTRUMENT/UNIFORM costs for Woodwinds and Brass only

Marching Shoes - \$37.00 (to be paid for at the band camp meeting on Aug 1)
Gloves (approx. 5 pair) - \$4.00 ea. (to be paid for at the band camp meeting on Aug 1)
Uniform Dry Clean \$8.00 (District pays for it once, you pay for it in November just before turning the uniform back in)
Instrument Cleaning/Maintenance - \$35.00-\$100.00 - Paid for at the end of the year prior to checking the instrument back in. The instruments will be assessed by Music and Arts Center, but you can also take it to your repair shop to get it cleaned and repaired after the season.

INSTRUMENT/UNIFORM costs for Percussion only

Marching Shoes - \$37.00 (to be paid for at the band camp meeting on Aug 1)
Battery Percussion maintenance cost (heads) \$50.00
Pit Percussion fall season mallet costs \$45.00 (approx)
Uniform Dry Clean \$8.00 (District pays for it once, you pay for it in November just before turning the uniform back in)

INSTRUMENT/UNIFORM costs for Color Guard Only (to be paid for after Band Camp)

Custom Uniform – approx. \$150.00
Body tights - \$20.00
Gloves - \$15.00
Dance Shoes - \$20.00
Rifle - \$30.00
Sabre (optional) - \$85.00
