



CdS Marching Band Lock-In

Sat. Oct. 23 (after ASU Band Day)

After ASU Band Day, the Band Council will be hosting the first annual BAND LOCK-IN – a chaperoned Band “sleep-over” at the school. The Band Council has planned a great evening of snacks, video games, board/card games, movies, and other activities. The event will be chaperoned by Mr. DuPlessis and other parent volunteers. The Lock-In is designed to be a bonding activity for the Band similar to Band Camp, as well as a celebration of the hard work all the students have put into the marching band show this year!

THIS IS AN OPTIONAL EVENT FOR ALL MARCHING BAND STUDENTS. NO STUDENT IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND. THE LOCK-IN IS A CHAPERONED EVENT AND WILL BE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS. All school and band rules still apply (including dress code) – and anyone breaking these rules will be sent home immediately.

About 6:15 PM: Arrive at Corona from ASU Band Day and unload. You may go back home to shower, change, and get your sleeping bag, pillow, etc. for the lock in.

8 PM: Doors Re-Open for Lock-In (no one will be admitted after 8 PM)

1 AM: Girls and Boys separate into two different rooms for sleeping (**bring a sleeping bag and pillow!**) Girls and Boys will have to stay in these rooms until wakeup time!

7 AM: Wake-up Time! The Band Boosters will be serving a PANCAKE BREAKFAST for all the band members!

8 AM: Band members may be picked up by parents or leave on their own at this time (no one will be allowed to leave earlier). Certain sections are responsible for clean-up.

PERMISSION FORM FOR THE LOCK-IN (DUE THURSDAY)

Parents: If you sign the permission form for the lock-in, your student MUST STAY FROM 8 PM UNTIL 8 AM. NO ONE WILL BE ADMITTED IN LATE, AND NO ONE MAY LEAVE EARLIER. This is for the safety of the students!!
